

A look back on 2009

. Perhaps the second most significant development concerning end time Biblical prophecy is in the Middle East peace process. While negotiations have been stalled for over a year now since the breakdown of Annapolis, world patience with Israel in particular is at an all time low.

In regards to the building of the Third Temple, as prophesied in Revelation 11:2, we have had several significant developments this year. During a meeting with the recently re-established Sanhedrin, the highest religious authority in Israel, a prominent

called for the rebuilding of the Jewish Temple. The Temple Institute completed the manufacture of the

[Golden Censers](#)

which sit in the Holy Place, and also began building the foundation of the

[altar](#)

itself on the anniversary of the destruction of the First and Second Temples. 2009 was also the year that Israeli firms discovered

off the coast of Haifa, in enough quantities to ensure they will no longer be dependant on Arab or Russian exports, yet another Bible prophecy fulfilled (Deuteronomy 33:24).
