Quote: *"I deplore the Israeli military operation carried out last night in Beit Hanoun, which has resulted in the deaths of 18 people, mostly civilians," Solana said in a statement. "It is high time to break the cycle of violence that I condemn in the strongest terms." He said these military operations must be halted. "We must give a chance to the process of reconciliation between Palestinians. **President (Mahmoud) Abbas must be fully supported in his efforts to form a new government.**"*
