That phrase, *'the future is in our hands'*, does seem to imply that it could have something to do with the Temple Mount and the rebuilding of the Jewish Temple. On June 7<sup>th</sup>

th

1967, when Israeli paratroopers ran toward the Western Wall to celebrate the liberation of Jerusalem after 2500 years of Gentile rule, the statement was made over the army radio, *'The Temple Mount is in our hands!'*

. Sadly it did not remain that way for long, and in just a few hours, Israeli Defence Minister Moshe Dayan handed control of the Temple Mount back to the Jordanian Waqf. Could this important news be something to do with the status of the Temple Mount?

Other recent news updates from the Temple Institute, and those associated with it, have been extremely interesting. Just a few weeks ago, Rabbi Yehuda Glick revealed that [billions of dollars worth of gold](#) could be buried under the Eilat mountains in the south, which could be used to finance the rebuilding of the Temple.
